Secured complete summary judgment for the defendant at the trial court level and affirmed, after oral argument, before the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.

Defended Environmental Insurance Company in Case Related to Contamination at Cement Manufacturing Plant

Successfully defended an insurance company in environmental insurance coverage litigation related to environmental contamination at a cement manufacturing plant in Southern California. Successfully lead the team of experts to investigate and create a theory for the characterization of the fate and transport of contamination which had confused many experts, consultants and regulators for many years.
